CALL FOR THE ATRIBUTION OF ONE PHD SCHOLARSHIP

In 2014, the PhD Programme in Migration Studies (DeMig), was awarded financial approval from the Fundação para a Ciência e Tecnologia, I.P. (FCT, I.P.), in the ambit of the call for "FCT Doctoral Programmes". In total, 14 PhD scholarships were assigned to the programme (to be awarded in four successive editions). In 2018, an extension of the "FCT Doctoral Programme" was granted and 4 additional PhD scholarships were awarded.

It is the responsibility of the Scientific Committee of the DeMig Programme to select the students who will be granted the scholarships financed by FCT, I.P. The research scholarship contracts are signed directly with this entity.

All the information on this doctoral programme, organised jointly by the **Institute of Geography and Spatial Planning (IGOT), Faculty of Psychology (FP), Institute of Social Sciences (ICS) and Institute of Education (IE)** of the University of Lisbon, is available at: <http://www.igot.ulisboa.pt/ensino/doutoramento-em-migracoes/>.

Thus, within the scope of the Research Fellowship Holder Statute, approved by Law no. 40/2004, of 18 August, subsequently amended and republished by Decree-law no. 202/2012, of 27 August, later updated by Decree-Law no. 233/2012, of 29 October, by Law no. 12/2013, 29 January, and by Decree-Law no. 89/2013, of 9 July, and the Fundação para a Ciência e a Tecnologia Regulation of the Research Scholarships, the Scientific Committee of the Doctoral Programme in Migration Studies opens a call for the selection of scholarship holders to award individual scholarships for this doctoral programme in the academic year of 2019/2020.

1. NUMBER OF DOCTORAL SCHOLARSHIPS (BD) TO BE AWARDED: One (1)

2. DURATION OF THE SCHOLARSHIP: The duration of the scholarship is annual, extendable to a maximum of four years, not being able to be awarded for periods shorter than six consecutive months.

3. BENEFICIARIES

Who can apply to this call:

- National citizens or citizens of other EU Member States;
- Citizens of third-party states, holders of a valid residence permit or beneficiaries of a long-term resident status.

4. HOST INSTITUTION

Host institutions are all institutions participating in the doctoral programme in terms of the agreement and the regulations of the PhD Programme in Migration Studies.

5. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Without prejudice to the provisions referred to in number 2, candidates for this call must submit their application to attend DeMig in the academic year 2019/2020, from the from December 31, 2019 and until January 31, 2020, in accordance with the requirements available in the respective application form, accessible at: <http://www.igot.ulisboa.pt/>.

6. FORMALIZATION OF APPLICATIONS

In addition to completing the application form referred to in the preceding paragraph, the application for the Doctorate Scholarships referred to in this Notice must be made by letter addressed to the Director of DeMig, stating the acknowledgement and acceptance of the terms and rules of the FCT, I.P. Research Scholarships Regulation, in particular with regard to the provision of the required documentation.

7. PERIOD OF SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS

The call is open between December 31, 2019 and January 31, 2020.

8. ADDRESS FOR SENDING APPLICATIONS

The letters of formalization of the scholarship applications to be awarded, in the terms referred to in number 5 of this Notice, should be sent to the Institute of Geography and Spatial Planning of the University of Lisbon (with the reference "PhD Grant nº 1/2015) by e-mail: academicos@igot.ulisboa.pt or to the address: Edifício do IGOT, Rua Branca Edmée Marques, 1600-276 LISBOA, and must be received within the aforementioned deadline.

9. SELECTION AND EVALUATION OF APPLICATIONS

The selection and evaluation of applications leading to the granting of scholarships will be carried out by a jury composed of the Scientific Committee of the DeMig Programme, chaired by its Director.

All applications are scored from 1 (minimum) to 10 (maximum) in the three evaluation criteria considered: A. merit of the *candidate*, B. merit of the *work programme* and C. *motivation and ability to carry out advanced research*.

Candidates will be ranked according to the weighted average of the classification of the three criteria. The weighting factors are, respectively, 4, 4 and 2.

$$\text{Final classification} = \frac{4A+4B+2C}{10}$$

A. Merit of the candidate

- Bachelor Degree classification
- Master Degree classification
- *Curriculum vitae* and professional experience (relevant to the theme of the PhD)

B. Work programme

- Clarity and originality of research goals
- Scientific relevance of the research topic
- Adequacy of the proposed research methodology
- Feasibility of the research project


C. Motivation and ability to carry out advanced research (evaluated through an interview. For candidates residing abroad, the interview can be conducted by skype).

10. PUBLICATION OF RESULTS

The evaluation results will be publicized for consultation by the candidates, in a public place at IGOT and sent by e-mail. If the decision to be taken is unfavourable to the granting of the requested scholarship, candidates who so wish have a period of 10 working days, after the publication, to pronounce themselves, in a preliminary hearing, under the terms established in the Administrative Procedure Code. The final decision may be appealed to the Fundação para a Ciência e Tecnologia, I.P., within a period of 15 working days, after the respective notification.
